KEY STRATEGIES AND INITIATIVES

- Intellectual and Cultural Enrichment Initiative: Provide curricular activities for students that
 enhance both intellectual and cultural enrichment including support of the Violin Program in
 partnership with the Huntsville Symphony Orchestra staff.
- Staff Recognition Initiative: Increase public recognition and appreciation of teachers and other school staff members through the annual Gratitude Banquet for Teachers of the Year.
- **Grants Initiative:** Continue to promote learning support through grants awarded to applicants annually and expand fundraising efforts for greater grant opportunities.
- **Student Support:** Empower students utilizing the Ralph & Lib Brett funds to meet needs that may impede a student's ability to participate in educational activities.
